Job Purpose/Summary

The PUMA Senior Mechanics Technician Onshore is responsible for maintaining all PUMA equipment at the Company base. He has as main role to ensure that the Pulling Unit tools, machinery, equipment and other resources are effectively maintained to properly operate and guarantee optimization of the profitability of the company's site operations. He must also ensure that stocks of mechanical spare parts are monitored. He will report to the Well Service superintendent.

Main Mission/Result Area PRIMARY ACCOUNTABILITIES

- Perform or assist with preventative maintenance when required.
- Plan and organise the PUMA equipment maintenance schedule.
- Ensure that the necessary spare parts are available in the shops to keep all our equipment working properly.
- Keep machinery and equipment clean.
- Ensure that all equipment and associated products (fittings, rods, etc.) are used to their full potential, while ensuring their durability.
- Troubleshooting and repairing all mechanical, hydraulic and diesel equipment.
- Take personal responsibility and be fully accountable for the achievement of all defined objectives.
- Intervene offshore, to support the mechanic present during a serious breakdown.
- Make trips on the Puma Rig to discuss maintenance follow-up with the mechanic.
- Replace the Offshore mechanic in case of prolonged absence.



HSSE Accountabilities

- Participate in all HSSE intervention schemes (APIPP, Incident reporting, site visits) and awareness sessions (HSSE Meetings, events and trainings) to maintain and improve Company HSSE culture and performance.
- Understand the emergency procedure and the related requirements.

The incumbent may perform other related duties as assigned.

Key Challenges

- Demonstrate a personal commitment to all HSSE procedures, and instructions.
- Ability to multitask and provide assistance when required.
- Exposed to regular physical plant noises, smells related to repairing and inspecting plant equipment.
- Convey a professional appearance and attitude continuously.
- The incumbent will work on 5 days on / 2 days off.

- Maintain a high level of safety awareness and standards in all daily duties and tasks.
