Main Mission/Result Area

- Identify and prepare parts for wellheads, Christ-mass trees, valves, and associated seals which required repair and or replacement,
- Participate to wellhead integrity testing.
- During drilling and workovers, participate to wellhead installation activities.
- Refer to wellhead manufacturer and associated industry standards.
- Work safely and efficiently.
- Function/leak testing to API standards.
- Greasing of valves.
- Conduct routine inspections of equipment.
- Perform routine maintenance and repairs on wellhead equipment and instrumentation.
- Comply with safety and environmental regulations and company policies.
- Assist in the installation and commissioning of new wellhead equipment as required.
- Provide support to other areas of the production operation as needed

- Participate in all HSSE intervention schemes (APIPP, Incident reporting, site visits) and awareness sessions (HSSE Meetings, events, and trainings) to maintain and improve Company HSSE culture and performance.
- Understand the emergency procedure and the related requirements
